Please keep in mind that space around your booth is limited. Tables may be located on the Library Main level, Auditorium, Carnegie level or Youth Services level of the Library. As well, tables will be throughout the Tom Thomson Art Gallery. The location of your table and your table size will be determined by Library staff and may be subject to change.

The OSNGUPL Author Fair starts at 1:00 pm.</li> <li>Those setting up the booth and dismantling the booth will need to be able to lift and carry all their booth items from their car to the booth and back as we do not have a loading area nor staff to assist.</li> <li>The Library will set aside a locked space for authors to leave their books, tablecloths etc. Friday night to Saturday at noon for storage. The Library is not liable for these items.</li> <li>You must always have a representative at your booth during the hours of the fair.</li> <li>Booths with power outlets are limited and we will make every effort to provide them to all who require one, however we cannot guarantee it.</li> <li>Yes, I would like to have a power outlet if available.</li> </ul>
