The Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library is seeking a high school student, who is at least 14 years old, for the role of part-time Shelving Assistant. The Library provides a supportive, engaging environment for an enthusiastic student ready to gain valuable work experience.

The Shelving Assistant will work on all levels of the Library primarily re-shelving books and other materials in the collection with a high degree of accuracy. They are responsible for maintaining a welcoming space for patrons by tidying and performing light cleaning duties in public areas. They may be required to interact with the public to provide directional assistance or to refer patrons to Information or Circulation staff when appropriate. Shelving Assistants may have the opportunity to work on other Library projects as assigned.

The successful candidate must be mature and responsible, with a positive, friendly attitude. This position also requires significant attention to detail and an understanding of basic Library organization principles to ensure that patrons and staff can find materials efficiently.

Shelving Assistants work an average of 7 hours per week, consisting of two regular 3-hour shifts plus rotating Saturdays.
