#### **LEGO®** Building Competition Guidelines

Using your own LEGO® or LEGO® provided by the Library, design and build your own creation (not from a designed kit). **Please do not mix personal and Library-supplied LEGO®**.

#### **Judging and Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded in 5 categories: Grades JK-2, Grades 3-5, Grades 6-8, Family Builds, and People's Choice. We reserve the right to adjust the categories based on submissions received.

#### **Rules**

- 1. Use your own LEGO®, DUPLO®, Mega Bloks® or other LEGO® compatible plastic bricks. Alternatively, come to the Building Bee at the Library to make your creation.
- 2. Entries must be your own creation, not a LEGO® designed kit, project found online, in a magazine, etc.
- 3. Your creation must be on a base no bigger than 24 by 24 inches. The base can be wood, cardboard, a LEGO® flat base, etc. and can be decorated to fit with your project. Your completed project may be no taller than four feet tall.
- 4. One entry per participant or team where applicable.
- 5. "Family Build" team projects will be placed in their own category, and all ages are welcome to contribute. A team will compete for a single prize.
- 6. Deliver completed projects to Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library, 824 1st Avenue West during the drop off time noted above.
- 7. The Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library cannot be held responsible for any lost or damaged LEGO®.
- 8. Completed entries MUST be taken home after the awards ceremony on the evening of November 6 or on November 7 from 10 am 1 pm. The Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library cannot be held responsible for creations left after assigned pickup period.
