Owen Sound, Ontario – Wednesday, September 9, 2026 – We are pleased to announce the fall session of our monthly Gardener in Residence program generously provided by the Grey County Master Gardeners.

The Gardeners in Residence will be in the Library on Tuesday, September 15, Tuesday, October 20, and Tuesday, November 17 in the Auditorium from 2:00 -3:30 pm. The Gardening Demo begins at 2:00 pm, (registration required) followed by a Drop-in Advice Clinic from 3:00-3:30 pm.

September's garden demo is Rethinking Your Garden. In this practical session you will be lead through the garden design steps to rethink and revitalize your outdoor oasis.

In October attend an interactive session demonstrating the difference between bulbs and tubers. How and when to plant. How and when to lift and store for winter. Bring your questions!

November's demonstration will focus on Grey County Master Gardeners favourite tools. What tool to use and how to use them correctly. Types of pruners. Sharpening and maintenance techniques.

Master Gardeners (MGs) in the Province of Ontario are experienced gardeners who have studied horticulture extensively and continue to upgrade their skills through technical training. With this training and continuing education, Master Gardeners provide expert horticultural advice to the public.
